
Course Report November 2024

Hi Members:

It's great to be able to report to you the ongoing activities and plans for the course's maintenance and development.

Since gaining the task of heading course activities there has been plenty happening that has kept the team busy. It has included forming the new Course Committee and looking at the present and future requirements. This is happening while we deal with many of the day-to-day issues that arise as well as the work being done around the course by the ground staff and volunteers alike, to which I would like to shout out my sincere appreciation for their efforts.

At this point in our new tenure, I am going to dispense with the generalities of what is good and bad regarding maintenance, projects and equipment, but let me assure you there has been a great deal of action happening in the background. The most important thing currently is capturing "everything" (good ideas, current issues, future planning, budgeting, etc) so that we have a sound baseline for what we tackle and in what order they are tackled on base of priority, available labour and finance. To this end we have obtained software that will capture and manage all these issues. It is currently being populated with the data we have gathered so far with the hope that we will be running with a live version in the short term. When this occurs it is also our intention to make it visible to any member who wishes to view it, and I will announce this as the time draws closer. We can however tell you that the confirmed first group of priority tasks as to evaluate fact from fiction and capture as many issues and ideas as we can, have been identified. This will be done through a series of audits which can be viewed from the database below:
