Congratulations also to Gail McInnes and Shane Payne who took out the Mixed Foursomes Championships. The nett event was won by Jenny Walker and Graeme Sheers. Well done to the winners and all who took part.

One of the last things the ground staff do on a Friday is fluff up the bunkers with the bunker machine. If you are playing late on a Friday afternoon and you notice that someone has been in a bunker and not raked it properly, could you please rake it for them. (bloody green fee players) I'm sure the morning players the next day would appreciate your efforts. There is nothing worse than landing in a footprint in a bunker. They are hard enough to get out of at the best of times.

On the 21 of August five players from our club ventured to Royal Melbourne to play in the Seniors Classic. The course was in great condition, but it was quite windy, which made it very difficult to score well, to say the least. There were a number of times when a ball got within six feet of the pin only to run back down to where it was hit from. I think four times in a row was the record. Three of the group managed to bring up "the ton" but a great day was had by all. It's not often you have 115 off the stick and have a good collect in the scats. No names, no pack drill!

Saturday September 9th is the date allocated to BMGC for The Scramble. This is a four person Ambrose event. Players will need to opt into The Scramble and book through the website. Each team must have at least one BMGC member. The winning team will play in the Regional Final with the chance to advance to the State and National Final. Every player participating will receive 6 Calloway golf balls and a chance to share in some great prizes on the day.

We need to have 48 players enter to qualify a team for the Regional Final. The cost for BMCG members is \$45 per player and \$60 for visitors.

Two important rules that I noted are:

- •only 2 single figure handicap players per team
- •only players with official GA handicaps can enter.

There will be a four person Ambrose event run on the day for members who do not wish to enter The Scramble. There will be an 8am and 12:30pm shotgun start. The club event will be run under the same rules as for The Scramble.

Well done to the ground staff for the way they have been presenting the course. They have been doing a great job. There are still some problems with the pump (waiting on parts) All indications are for a dry summer this year - anything we can do to help with course care will be appreciated. Please remember to fill in your divots, repair pitch marks on the greens and rake bunkers.

Please note we have a rule regarding practice on the course. We ask that you play no more than two balls while practising on the course and if you are playing two balls, make sure you are not holding other players up. Make sure you fill divots, repair pitch marks and rake bunkers when you are practising as well. No news from the Match Committee this month as we haven't had a meeting since our last newsletter.
